- Details of the location of the site are essential. Eight-figure grid reference (e.g. ST35466791) is ideal, and owners should be assured that no information will be made public. If there are concerns with confidentiality then a four-figure grid reference (e.g. ST3567) would be a minimum.
- Details of any existing or previous agri-environment scheme agreements on the farm would be very useful, particularly if there are management options in place for arable plants.
- The list of plants includes 54 of the UK's most threatened arable plants, 20 of them are on the UK Biodiversity Action Plan (UKBAP) Priority List.
- The occurrence of a good population of any of the Critically Endangered or Endangered plants would make the site an Important Arable Plant Area of national importance.
